The Lake County Property Appraiser (LCPA) no longer provides custom data requests. LCPA's tax roll data is offered for free on our FTP site. The data is provided in both csv and Excel formats. Data is updated once a month at the beginning of the month. The following files are provided:

- Area – Contains building sub areas and their square footages including, effective, gross, and heated area for each building on a parcel.
- Bldg – Contains various building information on each building on a parcel. (Ex. Residential/commercial, exterior wall types, AYB/EYB, values)
- Exemptions – Contains exemption number, and description for each parcel with an exemption.
- Land – Contains land line information for each parcel.
- Legal with Living – Contains legal description and total living area for the building.
- NALExtractPublic – Contains ownership information, land use codes, values, and exemption information among other data.
- Parcel Values – Contains land, building, and xfob values.
- Permits – Contains all LCPA's permit information. This is not the official permit information. You would have to get that data from the permitting department.
- Sales – Contains all sales data (all years).
- Subdivision Info – Contains subdivision information.
- Xfob – Contains any miscellaneous features on a parcel. (ex. Pool, utility bldg, and detached garage).
